**A LAW to Amend the Real Property Representative  
Law, 1955**

**Enacted by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.**

**1— This Law may be cited as the Real Property Representative (Amendment) Law, 1965, and shall be read and construed as one with the Real Property Representative Law, 1955, hereinafter referred to as the principal Law, and all amendments thereto, and shall come into operation on a day to be published by the Administrator by Government Notice in the Cayman Islands.**

Amendment of  
Section 2 of  
principal Law.

2— Sub-section (4) of Section 2 of the principal Law is hereby amended by deleting that subsection and substituting therefor the following —

“(4) This Section shall apply retrospectively to the 1st day of December, 1903.”.

Amendment of  
Section 3 of  
principal Law.

3— Sub-section (2) of Section 3 of the principal Law is hereby amended by deleting that subsection and substituting therefor the following —

“(2) This Section shall apply retrospectively to the 1st day of December, 1903, where there has been after the 1st day of December, 1903 a Grant of Probate or Letters of Administration whether the death occurred before or after the said date.”.

Deletion of  
Section 8  
of principal  
Law.

4— Section 8 of the principal Law is hereby deleted and the following substituted therefor —

“Validity of  
Probate and  
Letters of  
Adminis-  
tration.

All grants of Probate and Letters of Administration issued after the 1st day of December, 1903 in respect of deaths occurring between that date and the commencement of the Principal Law are deemed to have been effective as if the provisions of the Principal Law were then in force.”.
