A LAW to Amend the Firearms Law, 1964.

Enacted by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

1. This Law may be cited as the Firearms (Amendment) Law, 1965. Short title.

2. Section 2 of the Firearms Law, 1964 (hereinafter referred to as the Principal law) is hereby amended by substituting the words "has served imprisonment for three months or upwards and has been released within five years" for the words "has been convicted and sentenced to imprisonment for any offence" where they occur in the definition of "restricted person" therein. Amendment of section 2 of Law 17 of 1964.

Amendment of  
section 8

3. Section 8 of the principal law is hereby amended by substituting the words "Firearm Disposal Permit" for the words "Firearm Vendor's Permit" wherever they occur in subsections (2) and (3) thereof.

Amendment of  
section 21.

4. Section 21 of the principal law is hereby amended—  
(a) by the insertion of the figures "(1A)," between the word "subsections" and the figure "(2)" where they occur in the second line thereof; and  
(b) by the insertion of a new subsection immediately following subsection (1):

"(1A) No licence or permit under this Law shall be granted to any person who —

(a) is of intemperate habits liable to fits of uncontrolled temper, notoriously careless in the use of firearms, is of unsound mind; or

(b) is for any reason unfitted to be entrusted with a firearm."

Passed by the Assembly this 4th day of October 1965.
