A LAW to Amend the Lobster (Restriction on Fishing)  
Law, 1964.

Enacted by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

1. This Law may be cited as the Lobster (Restriction on Fishing) (Amendment) Law, 1965. Short title.

2. Section 7 of the Lobster (Restriction on Fishing) Law, 1964 (hereinafter referred to as the principal law) is hereby amended by substituting the words "If any person takes" for the words "Any person who takes" in the first line thereof. Amendment of Section 7 of Law 18 of 1964.

3. Section 9 of the principal law is hereby amended by inserting the word "of" between the words "therefrom" and "any lobster" in the second line of paragraph (ii) thereof.
