A LAW to apply a sum of money for the Service of the period 1st January, 1964 to 31st December, 1964.

WHEREAS the amount of Two hundred and eighty-eight thousand seven hundred and fifty pounds is required for the service of the period 1st of January, 1964 to 31st December, 1964.

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

- I. This Law may be cited as the Appropriation Law, 1964. Short title
2. The Treasurer of these Islands shall pay a sum not exceeding in the aggregate Two hundred and eighty-eight thousand seven hundred and fifty pounds for defraying the several charges and expenses of the Civil Government of these Islands, and for other purposes for the period 1st of January, 1964 to 31st December, 1964 as set forth in the Schedule to this Law, and such sum is hereby charged upon the revenue and funds of these Islands.
