A LAW to Amend the Medical Evidence Law, 1947, Law 3 of 1947

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

1—This Law may be cited as the Medical Evidence (Amendment) Law, 1964, and shall be read and construed as one with the Medical Evidence Law, 1947, (hereinafter referred to as the principal Law) and all amendments thereto, and shall come into force on a day to be published by the Administrator by Government Notice.

2—Section 2 subsections (1) and (2) of the principal Law are hereby amended as follows-

Amendment of  
Section 2 of  
principal Law.

- (1) By placing a comma immediately after the word "practitioner" in line four of subsection (1) and by inserting the words "chemist, pathologist or analyst" between the words "practitioner" and "who" in line four of this subsection;

- (2) by placing a comma immediately after the word “practitioner” in line seven of subsection (1) and by inserting the words “chemist, pathologist or analyst” between the words “practitioner” and “being” in line seven of this subsection;
- (3) by placing a comma immediately after the word “practitioner” in line nine of subsection (2) and by inserting the words “chemist, pathologist or analyst” between the words “practitioner” and “to” in line nine of this subsection.

Amendment of  
Section 3 of  
principal Law

3—Section 3 of the principal Law is hereby amended by placing a comma immediately after the word “practitioner” in line four of this section and by inserting the words “chemist, pathologist or analyst” between the words “practitioner” and “who” in line four of this section.
