A LAW to allow and confirm certain expenditure during the financial year 1961.

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

1. This Law may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation (1961) Law, 1964. Short title.

2. The expenditure during the financial year ending the 31st December, 1961 to the amount of Nineteen Thousand Three hundred and eighty seven Pounds (£19,387) on the services set forth in the Schedule to this Law annexed and not provided for by Law 4 of 1961 is hereby allowed and confirmed. Expenditure of £19,387 in 1961 confirmed.
