A LAW to amend the Cayman Islands Lighthouse Law, 1919.

Enacted by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

1-This Law may be cited as the Cayman Islands short title, Lighthouse (Amendment) Law, 1964, and shall be read and construed as one with the Cayman Islands Lighthouse Law, 1919 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Law) and all amendments thereto, and shall come into force on a day to be published by the Administrator by Government Notice.

SCHEDULE

One shilling on every nett ton or part thereof up to 100 tons, and

Six Pence on every nett ton thereafter up to a maximum charge of £50.".
