THE EXCHANGE CONTROL (GOVERNMENT OF THE CAYMAN ISLANDS EXEMPTION) ORDER 1966

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Controller of Exchange by Section 3 of the Exchange Control Regulations Law, 1966, and of Regulation 29 of the Exchange Control Regulations, 1966, (hereinafter called the Regulations) the following Order is hereby made.

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Exchange Control (Government of the Cayman Islands Exemption) Order, 1966.
- 2. There shall be exempted from the provisions of paragraphs (1) and (2) of Regulations 1, and of paragraph (1) of Regulation 2 of the Regulations the Government of the Cayman Islands in respect of dealings in foreign currency.
- 3. There shall be exempted from the provisions of Regulations 5 and of paragraph (1) of Regulation 6 of the Regulations the Government of the Cayman Islands in respect of payment made or intended to be made in foreign currency outside the Scheduled territories.
- 4. The Controller of Exchange may at any time direct that the exemption conferred by this Order shall not apply as may be specified in the direction.

EXPLANATORY NOTE
