LAW 4 OF 1966

THE EXCHANGE CONTROL (SPECIFIED CURRENCY)
ORDER, 1966.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Controller of Exchange by Section 3 of the Exchange Control Regulations Law, 1966, and by Regulation 2 of the Exchange Control Regulations 1966, (hereinafter referred to as the Regulations) the following Order is hereby made:-

1. This Order may be cited as the Exchange Control (Specified Currency) Order, 1966.
2. The foreign currency set out in the Schedule to this Order is hereby specified as foreign currency to which paragraph 1 of Regulation 2 applies.
3. The Exchange Control (Specified Currency) Order, 1958 is hereby revoked.
