THE EXCHANGE CONTROL REGULATIONS LAW, 1966 LAW 4 OF 1966

THE EXCHANGE CONTROL (TEMPORARY VISITORS' EXEMPTION) ORDER, 1960.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Controller of Exchange by Section 3 of the Exchange Control Regulations Law, 1966, and of Regulation 29 of the Exchange Control Regulations, 1966, (hereinafter referred to as the Regulations) the following Order is hereby made:-

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Exchange Control (Temporary Visitors' Exemption) Order, 1966.
- 2. There shall be exempted from the obligations imposed by the provisions of Regulation 2 of the Regulations any person in the Cayman Islands who is not resident in the Cayman Islands.
- 3. The Controller of Exchange may at any time direct that the exemption conferred by this Order shall not apply to such person as may be specified in the direction.
- 4. The Exchange Control (Temporary Visitors' Exemption) Order, 1958, is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order exempts temporary visitors to the Cayman Islands from the provisions of the Law which relate to the surrender of gold and specified foreign currency.
