THE REGISTRATION OF CLUBS LAW, 1955 (Law No. 3 of 1955)

THE REGISTRATION OF CLUBS (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1966.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Administrator by section 18 of the Registration of Clubs Law, 1955, the following Regulations are, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly, hereby made -

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Registration of Clubs (Amendment) Regulations, 1966 and shall come into operation on a day to be appointed by the Administrator by Government Notice published in the Cayman Islands.

2. Regulation 4 of the Registration of Clubs Regulations, 1961 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Regulations) is deleted and replaced as follows -

“4. Intoxicating Liquor shall not be supplied to a member of any club or to his guest except between the hours of 10.00 a.m. and 2.00 a.m. on week days nor save between the hours of 10.00 a.m. and 12 midnight on any Sunday, Christmas Day and Good Friday, nor under any circumstances may supply or consumption extend from any day into the early hours of any Sunday, Christmas Day and Good Friday.”.

3. The principal Regulations are hereby amended by re-numbering Regulation 7 as Regulation 8 and inserting the following new Regulation 7 -

“7. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of these Regulations shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction in the case of a first offence to a penalty not exceeding five pounds and in the case of a second or subsequent offence to a penalty not exceeding ten pounds.”.
