The Hotels Aid (Amendment) Regulations, 1967

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Administrator by section 16 of the Hotels Aid Law the following regulations on the recommendation of the Licensing Board are hereby made -

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Hotels Aid (Amendment) Regulations, 1967.
2. The Form of Licence (Form 2) in the First Schedule to the Hotels Aid Regulations, 1967 is hereby amended by deleting the words:-

“percentage of the full Customs Duties and Tonnage Tax would ordinarily be payable but for the provisions of this Law”,

and substituting therefor the words:-

“the duties payable pursuant to section 5 of the Hotels Aid Law.”
