THE WORKING DAYS AND HOURS AND SCALES OF REMUNERATION (AMENDMENT) (NO.2) REGULATIONS, 1967.

Cap. 31

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Customs Law, the following Regulations are hereby made by the Administrator in Council.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Working Days and Hours and Scales of Remuneration (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations and shall be read and construed as one with the Working Days and Hours and Scales of Remuneration Regulations 1964 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Regulations) and shall come into operation on a date to be appointed by the Administrator by Government Notice published in the Cayman Islands.

2. Regulation 6 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by adding thereto the following Regulation as Regulation 6A:-

“ 6A. The scales of remuneration payable to watchmen shall be
