A LAW TO AMEND THE PUBLIC HOLIDAYS LAW, 1913

.

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

Short title and commencement.

1 - This Law may be cited as the Public Holidays (Amendment) Law, 1967 and shall come into operation on a day to be appointed by the Administrator by Government Notice published in the Cayman Islands.

New Schedule to Law 7 of 1913. 2 - The Schedule to the Public Holiday's Law, 1913 is hereby deleted and replaced as follows -

## "SCHEDULE

- 1. New Year's Day, or in case New Year's Day falls on Sunday, the day after New Year's Day.
- 2. Ash Wednesday.
- 3. Good Friday.
- 4. Easter Monday.
- 5. 3rd Monday in May, to be known as Commonwealth Day or Day of Tree planting by school children.
