A LAW TO AMEND THE PUBLIC HOLIDAYS LAW, 1913

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

Short title and commencement.

1 - This Law may be cited as the Public Holidays (Amendment) Law, 1967 and shall come into operation on a day to be appointed by the Administrator by Government Notice published in the Cayman Islands.

New Schedule to Law 7 of 1913.

2 - The Schedule to the Public Holidays Law, 1913 is hereby deleted and replaced as follows -

"SCHEDULE

1. New Year's Day, or in case New Year's Day falls on Sunday, the day after New Year's Day.
2. Ash Wednesday.
3. Good Friday.
4. Easter Monday.
5. 3rd Monday in May, to be known as Commonwealth Day or Day of Tree planting by school children.

2 (No. 4) The Public Holidays (Amendment) Law, 1967.

- 6. The day appointed by the Administrator to be kept as the birthday of the reigning Sovereign.
- 7. 1st Monday in July to be known as Constitution Day.
- 8. The Monday after Remembrance Sunday.
- 9. Christmas Day.
- 10. The day after Christmas Day, or when Christmas Day falls on a Saturday then the following Monday or when Christmas Day falls on a Sunday then the following Monday and Tuesday."

A LAW TO AMEND THE MOTOR VEHICLES LAW, 1961.

Short title and commencement.

1 - This Law may be cited as the Motor Vehicles (Amendment) Law, 1967, and shall come into operation on a day to be appointed by the Administrator by Government Notice published in the Cayman Islands.

2 - The Motor Vehicles Law 1961, is hereby amended by substituting the words "heavy vehicle" for the word "Transporter" in item 16 of Schedule B thereof.
