A LAW to Amend the Customs Law.
(Cap. 31)

Enacted by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

1. This Law may be cited as the Customs (Amendment)
Law, 1967 and shall come into operation on a day to be
appointed by the Administrator by Government Notice
published in the Cayman Islands.
