A Law to Amend the Import Duty and Tonnage Tax Law  
( CAP. 68 )

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

1. This Law may be cited as the Import Duty and Tonnage Tax (Amendment) Law, 1967 and shall come into operation on a day to be appointed by the Administrator by Government Notice published in the Cayman Islands.

2. The Fourth Schedule of the Import Duty and Tonnage Tax Law is hereby amended by substituting the following items for items 5 and 7
