A Law to Amend the Cayman Islands Corporation Law.

Cap. 16

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

1. This Law may be cited as the Cayman Islands Corporation (Amendment) Law, 1967 and shall come into operation on a day to be appointed by the Administrator by Government Notice published in the Cayman Islands.

Short title and commencement.

2. Section 3 of the Cayman Islands Corporation Law (hereinafter referred to as the principal law) is hereby amended as follows -

 - "4A A Chairman and a deputy Chairman shall be appointed by the Administrator, selected from among either the official members or the other members, as the Administrator may think fit."

Amendment of section 18.

- 3. Section 18 of the principal law is hereby amended by deleting and replacing subsection (1) as follows -
 - "(1) The Corporation shall in each year prepare and present on or before the 1st day of July to the Administrator a report of their proceedings during the twelve months ending on the 31st day of December of the preceding year, including a complete report of their financial position in such form as to secure the provision of separate information as respects each of the main activities of the Corporation.".
