3. The principal law is hereby amended by adding the following section thereto as section 10 -

"10..The Administrator in Council may make regulations generally for the better carrying out of the provisions of this law, and in particular but without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing power, such regulations may -

- (a) provide for the management and discipline of any dental clinic; and
- (b) prescribe the fees to be payable in respect of any treatment, accommodation, amenities, facilities, services or materials of any description provided by or through the Government, and provide for the manner in which such fees shall be collected, accounted for and disposed of."
