The Bicycles (Control) (Amendment) Law, 1967

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

()

1. This Law may be cited as the Bicycles (Control) (Amendment) Law, 1967, and shall be read and construed as one with the Bicycles (Control) Law (hereinafter referred to as the principal Law) and all amendments thereto, and shall come into operation on a day to be appointed by the Administrator by Government Notice published in the Cayman Islands.

Short title and commencement.

Cap. 10

2. The principal law is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section as section 13:-

Unlawful use of bicycles or tricycles.

"13. (1) Every person who takes and carries away any bicycle or tricycle without having either the

consent of the owner thereof or other lawful authority shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to imprisonment for a term not exceeding six months or to a fine not exceeding £25 and in default of payment thereof to imprisonment for a term not exceeding six months:

Provided that if the Magistrate is satisfied that the accused acted in the reasonable belief that the owner would, in the circumstances of the case, have given his consent if he had been asked therefor, the accused shall not be liable to be convicted of the offence.

(2) Any Constable may arrest without warrant any person reasonably suspected by him of having committed or attempted to commit an offence against this section."

The Motor Vehicles (Validation of Acts and Indemnity) Regulations Law, 1967.

A Law to validate the acts of all persons who purported to exercise the functions conferred by the Motor Vehicles Regulations 1961 and to indemnify the said persons against legal proceedings.

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

1. This Law may be cited as the Motor Vehicles (Validation of Acts and Indemnity) Law, 1967, and shall be read and construed as one with the Motor Vehicles Law.

Short title.
Cap. 106

2. The Motor Vehicles Regulations, 1961 purporting to have been made by the Administrator in Council under section 31 of the Motor Vehicles Law shall be deemed to have been so made on the 6th day of January 1962
