A LAW to Amend the Public Holidays Law

(Cap. 140)

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

1. This Law may be cited as the Public Holidays (Amendment) (No. 2) Law, 1967 and shall come into operation on a day to be appointed by the Administrator by Government Notice published in the Cayman Islands.
2. The Schedule to the Public Holidays Law is hereby amended by replacing item 6 as follows:-
"6. The Monday following the Saturday appointed

as the official birthday of the reigning Sovereign
