- (iii) under the heading "Survey of Ships", substitute "20" for "15" (appearing in 3 places);
- (iv) under the heading "Bottomry and Respondentia Bonds" substitute, respectively, "50" for "35", "12" for "8" and "30" for "20" (2 places);
- (v) under the heading "Miscellaneous" substitute "10" for "6" (2 places), "12" for "8" (2 places), and "20" for "15" (5 places).

A LAW TO AMEND THE NOTARIES PUBLIC LAW, 1982

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

Short Title and commencement.

No. 13 of 1982.

Amendment of Law

- 1. This Law may be cited as the Notaries Public (Amendment) Law, 1990, and shall come into force on the 31st day of December, 1990.
- 2. The Notaries Public Law, 1982, is amended in the following respects -
 - (a) in subsection (3)(c) of section 4, for the words "one hundred dollars" substitute the words "one hundred and fifty dollars";
 - (b) in section 7 for the words "fifty dollars" appearing in the third and fourth lines, substitute the words "seventy-five dollars";
 - (c) in the Fifth Schedule, in the right hand column -
 - (i) under the heading "Bills of Exchange" substitute "12" for "8" where the latter appears (2 places);
 - (ii) under the heading "Ships Protests" substitute "12" and "50", respectively, for "8" and "35";
