**A LAW TO AMEND THE NOTARIES PUBLIC LAW (1995 REVISION) IN
ORDER TO INCREASE FEES CHARGED UNDER THE LAW; AND FOR
INCIDENTAL AND CONNECTED PURPOSES**

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

1. This Law may be cited as the Notaries Public (Amendment) Law, 2001.

Short title
2. The Notaries Public Law (1995 Revision) is amended in section 4(2)(c) by repealing the words “one hundred and fifty” and substituting the words “five hundred”.

Amendment of section 4 of the Notaries Public Law (1995 Revision) - registration of notaries public
3. The Notaries Public Law (1995 Revision) is amended in section 7 by repealing the words “seventy-five” and substituting the words “two hundred and fifty”.

Amendment of section 7 of the notaries Public Law (1995 Revision) - payment of annual fees
