A LAW TO AMEND THE POSTAL LAW  
(LAW 25 OF 1977)

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Postal (Amendment) Law, 1983.

Substitution of section  
13 of Law 25 of 1977.

2. Section 13 of the Postal Law, in this Law referred to as the principal Law, is substituted by the following —

“Post Office 13. The Postmaster General may, subject to such machines conditions as he may impose, authorize prepayment and other of — impressions.  
(a) postage by means of post office franking machines, or by impressions made by printing press or other printing or stamping process;  
(b) revenue charges by means of post office franking machines.”.

Amendment of section  
24.

3. Section 24 of the principal law is amended by substituting the following new paragraph immediately after paragraph (1) —

“(1a) the acceptance of unaddressed mail;”.
