**A LAW TO AMEND
THE POWERS OF ATTORNEY LAW, 1979**

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

- Short title.
1. This Law may be cited as the Powers of Attorney (Amendment) Law, 1994.
- Interpretation.
2. In this Law "the principal Law" means the Powers of Attorney Law, 1979.
- Section 2 amended.
3. Subsections (1) and (2) of section 2 of the principal Law are amended by repealing "signed and sealed" and substituting "executed as a deed or as an instrument under seal".
- Section 6 amended.
4. (1) Subsection (1) of section 6 of the principal Law is amended by repealing paragraph (a) and substituting the following paragraph –

"(a) execute any instrument with his own signature and, if required, as a deed or other instrument under seal, and".
