In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by section 13 of the Port Authority Law, the following regulations are hereby made.

Citation.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Port (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations, 1986.

Addition of new regulation 125A.

2. The Port Regulations are amended by inserting the following new regulation immediately after regulation 125 -

"Designation of port anchorage

125A. The port anchorage area for the Port of George Town is prescribed in the Schedule."

Amendment of Schedule.

3. The Schedule to the Port Regulations is amended by adding the following at the end thereof -

PORT ANCHORAGE AREA (Regulation 125A)

The following area is designated the port anchorage area for the Port of George Town -

From Latitude 19 degrees, 18 minutes, 36 seconds North, and Longitude 81 degrees, 23 minutes, 19 seconds West; thence in a Westerly direction to a point at Latitude 19 degrees, 18 minutes, 36 seconds North, and Longitude 81 degrees, 23 minutes, 48 seconds West; thence in a Southerly direction to a point at Latitude 19 degrees, 17 minutes, 34 seconds North and Longitude 81 degrees, 23 minutes, 38 seconds West; thence in an Easterly direction to a point on the shore at Latitude 19 degrees 17 minutes, 34 seconds North, and Longitude 81 degrees, 23 minutes, 7 seconds West; and thence

along the Foreshore to Latitude 19 degrees, 18 minutes and 36 seconds North, and Longitude 81 degrees, 23 minutes and 19 seconds West.

Being all that area that includes waters and ocean bed to the average high water mark of Geroge Town Harbour lying within the defined limits so described.
