- (3) Where a provision of this Law that is applied to a statutory authority by virtue of an order made under subsection (1) is inconsistent with a provision of any other Law applying to that authority the provision of that other Law ceases to have effect in so far as it is inconsistent with the provision of this Law as applied to the authority.
- (4) In this section "statutory authority" means a body, whether or not incorporated, established by a Law.".

A LAW TO AMEND THE PUBLIC FINANCE AND AUDIT LAW, 1985

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Public Finance and Audit (Amendment) Law, 1993.

Law amended.

2. The Public Finance and Audit Law, 1985 is amended by inserting after section 2 the following section —

"Application to statutory authorities.

2A.(1) The Governor may, by order, declare that all or any provisions of this Law shall apply to a statutory authority specified in the order.

(2) An order made under subsection (1) may provide that a provision of this Law that is to apply to a statutory authority by virtue of the order shall apply to that authority as amended as specified in the order.
