EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations make a minor amendment to regulation 3 of the Garbage and Refuse Disposal (Amendment) Regulations 1975.

This is consequence of a new programme of garbage collection being implemented by the Department of the Environment. A semi-automated lifting device located on the back of its trucks will lift purpose built containers for the purposes of garbage and refuse collection.

THE GARBAGE AND REFUSE DISPOSAL (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 1994

The Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 50(2) of the Public Health Law, 1981, makes the following Regulations —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Garbage and Refuse Disposal (Amendment) Regulations 1994.

Containers for the collection of garbage
2. Regulation 3(b) of the Garbage and Refuse Disposal Regulations 1975 is amended by revoking the words "ensure that such containers are not less than ten gallons and not more than twenty-five gallons in capacity" and substituting the words "ensure that such containers are of a type and description approved by the Department".
