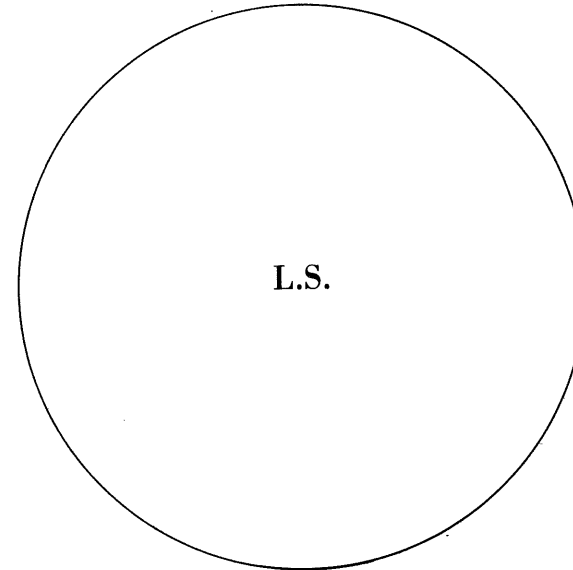

**MEMORANDUM OF OBJECTS AND REASONS**

It is desired to re-designate the public holiday celebrated on the third Monday in May as "Discovery Day".

**A LAW to amend the Public Holidays Law (Revised).**

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Public Holidays (Amendment) Law, 1977.

2. The Public Holidays Law (Revised) is amended by deleting from the Schedule item 5 and substituting —

"5. The third Monday in May, to be known as Discovery Day in commemoration of the discovery of the Cayman Islands by Christopher Columbus on the 10th of May, 1503."
