4. These rules shall come into operation on the first day of September, 1991:

PROVIDED that any unregistered form of transfer outstanding at this date, whether the form is dated or undated, shall have no effect after a lapse of sixty days from the date when these rules come into operation.

THE REGISTERED LAND (AMENDMENT) RULES 1991.

THE REGISTERED LAND LAW (REVISED) THE REGISTERED LAND (AMENDMENT) RULES 1991.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by section 161 of the Registered Land Law (Revised) the following rules are made –

- Citation. 1. These rules may be cited as the Registered Land (Amendment) Rules 1991, and shall be read as one with the Registered Land Rules (Revised) (hereinafter called the principal Rules").
- Amendment of rule 5 of the principal Rules. 2. Rule 5 of the principal rules is amended by –
(a) inserting "(1)" next after the figure "5";
(b) adding the following as paragraph (2) –
"(2) where any form specifies a time within which it is to be submitted to the Registrar in relation to a transaction, that form shall be submitted within the specified time, failing which the transaction shall not be registered."
- Amendment of Form R.L.1. 3. Form R.L.1. is amended by inserting the following immediately preceding the provision for the date thereof –
"This form shall be submitted to the Registrar for registration of this transfer not later than thirty days after the agreement between vendor and purchaser has been made."
