- (a) an amount equal to the registration fee, and
- b) payable in respect of each period of 45 days following the end of the period referred to in subsection (1)."

Amendment of section 107.

- 3. (1) Section 107 (1) of the principal Law is amended by repealing "executing an instrument" and substituting "signing an instrument by way of execution";
- (2) Section 107 (2) of the principal Law is amended by repealing "to that effect" and substituting -

"in the prescribed form as to these matters and to the effect that the person concerned signed the instrument before him in the appropriate place or places upon it.".

A LAW TO AMEND THE REGISTERED LAND LAW (REVISED)

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Registered Land (Amendment) Law, 1993.

Amendment of section 39.

2. Section 39 of the Registered Land Law (Revised), ("the principal Law"), is repealed and replaced by the following section -

"Time for registration.

- 39. (1) All instruments shall be presented for registration within 45 days of the signature of the first, or the only, named party therein.
- (2) Where an instrument is presented for registration after the period specified in subsection (1), there shall be payable, in addition to the registration fee, the late registration fee.
- (3) The late registration fee referred to in subsection (2) shall be -
