**A LAW TO ALLOW AND CONFIRM CERTAIN EXPENDITURE  
DURING THE FINANCIAL YEAR 1993**

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

1. This Law may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation (1993) Law, 2002. Short title
- (1997 Revision)2. The expenditure during the financial year ending 31 December, 1993 in the amount of \$3,065,418 on services set forth in Schedule I and not provided by the Appropriation Law, 1993 or by subsequent Finance Committee authority is allowed and confirmed as required under section 10 of the Public Finance and Audit Law (1997 Revision).
