## A LAW TO ALLOW AND CONFIRM CERTAIN EXPENDITURE **DURING THE FINANCIAL YEAR 1994**

**ENACTED** by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

1. This Law may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation (1994) Law, 2002.
