A LAW TO ALLOW AND CONFIRM CERTAIN EXPENDITURE  
DURING THE FINANCIAL YEAR 1995

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

1. This Law may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation (1995) Law, 2002.

Short title
2. The expenditure during the financial year ending 31 December, 1995 in the amount of \$6,769,273 on services set forth in Schedule I and not provided by the Appropriation (1995) Law, 1994 or by subsequent Finance Committee authority is allowed and confirmed as required under section 10 of the Public Finance and Audit Law (1997 Revision).
