A LAW TO ALLOW AND CONFIRM CERTAIN EXPENDITURE DURING THE
FINANCIAL YEAR 1996

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

1. This Law may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation (1996) Law, 2002.

The expenditure during the financial year ending 31 December, 1996 in the amount of \$10,198,374 on services set forth in Schedule I and not provided by the Appropriation (1996) Law, 1995 or by subsequent Finance Committee authority is allowed and confirmed as required under section 10 of the Public Finance and Audit Law (1997 Revision).
