## THE TOURISM LAW, 1974

### THE TOURISM (MORATORIUM ON NEW HOTEL CONSTRUCTION) ORDER, 1990

In exercise of the power conferred upon the Governor by subsection (1) of section 11A of the Tourism Law, 1974, the following order is hereby made -

- Citation. 1. This Order may be cited as the Tourism (Moratorium on New Hotel Construction) Order, 1990.
- Suspension of building permission. 2. (1) It is hereby ordered that for a period of three years from the 1st day of June, 1990, no permission may be granted for the construction of any new hotel in that part of the Island of Grand Cayman comprised of ALL THAT area of land extending northward from the northern boundary of the George Town Cemetery to the southern boundary of the West Bay Cemetery and running from the sea on its western side to the sea at North Sound on its eastern side.
- (2) This Order shall not apply to apartments, cottage colonies, or guest houses as defined in section 2 of the Law nor to those areas of land defined as Block No.17A Parcel 10 and Block No.10A Parcel 31 nor to any development project within the area defined in paragraph (1) in relation to which there exists, at the effective date of this Order, a general approval in principle by the Central Planning Authority.
