**A LAW TO AMEND
THE TOWNS AND COMMUNITIES LAW
(CAP. 169)**

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

Short Title.	1. This Law may be cited as the Towns and Communities (Amendment) Law, 1990.
Amendment of section 3 of the principal Law.	2. Section 3(1) of the Towns and Communities Law (Cap. 169) is amended by - <div><div>(a) deleting the words "or throws or sets fire to any firework" where they appear in line 3 of paragraph (o);"</div><div>(b) inserting the following new paragraph immediately after paragraph (s) -<div>"(t) in any public place sets fire to any firework except in accordance with the terms of a permit issued by the Chief Fire Officer"; and</div></div></div>
