(c) deleting the words "one hundred dollars or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding three months." where they appear in the last line thereof and substituting the words "one thousand dollars or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding six months." therefor.

A LAW TO AMEND THE TOWNS AND COMMUNITIES LAW (CAP. 169)

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

Short Title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Towns and Communities (Amendment) Law, 1990.

Amendment of section 3 of the principal Law.

- 2. Section 3(1) of the Towns and Communities Law (Cap. 169) is amended by -
 - (a) deleting the words "or throws or sets fire to any firework" where they appear in line 3 of paragraph (o);"
 - (b) inserting the following new paragraph immediately after paragraph (s) -
 - "(t) in any public place sets fire to any firework except in accordance with the terms of a permit issued by the Chief Fire Officer"; and
