THE TRADE AND BUSINESS LICENSING (AMENDMENT) LAW 1992 (Law 21 of 1992)

A LAW TO AMEND THE TRADE AND BUSINESS LICENSING LAW (REVISED)

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Trade and Business Licensing (Amendment) Law, 1992.

Commencement.

2. This Law shall commence, or shall be deemed to have commenced, as the case may be, on the day proclaimed by the Governor under section 1 of the Immigration Law for the commencement of that Law.

Interpretation.

3. In this Law the "principal Law" means the Trade and Business Licensing Law (Revised).

Section 2 amended.

4. Section 2 of the principal Law is amended by omitting the definition "Board" and substituting the following definition —

""Board" means the Immigration Board established by section 4 of the Immigration Law;".

Section 7 repealed.

5. Section 7 of the principal Law is repealed and the following section is substituted -

"Proceedings and policy to be followed by Board.

7. For the purpose of arriving at its decisions and for generally discharging its functions

under this Law the Board shall follow the procedures and policies prescribed by, or by virtue of the Immigration Law.".

Section 8 amended.

- 6. Section 8(1) of the principal Law is amended
 - (a) by omitting paragraph (a) and substituting the following paragraph
 - "(a) the applicant is a person of non-Caymanian status who does not hold a work permit as defined by the Immigration Law;";
 - (b) by omitting paragraph (e) and substituting the following paragraph
 - "(e) the applicant is a company that requires a licence under the Local Companies (Control) Law (Revised) to carry on business on the Islands and is not the holder of such a licence."

Section 14 replaced.

7. Section 14 of the principal Law is repealed and the following section substituted –

"Offences and penalties. 14. A person must not —

- (a) wilfully make a false or inaccurate representation to the Board; or
- (b) carry on or attempt to carry on without a licence a trade or business which is required to be licensed under this Law; or
- (c) being a person to whom a licence has been granted under this Law, carry on a trade or business in contravention of a condition or restriction contained in the licence.

Penalty: Fine not exceeding \$5,000 or imprisonment for a term not exceeding 12 months".

Section 15 amended.

8. Section 15 is amended by inserting after subsection (1) the following penalty -

"Penalty: Fine not exceeding \$5,000 or imprisonment for a term not exceeding 12 months".

Schedule amended.

9. The Schedule to the principal Law is amended by omitting from item 6 "Banks and Trust Companies Regulations Law (Revised)" and substituting "Banks and Trust Companies Law, 1989".
