**A LAW TO AMEND THE TRAFFIC LAW
(LAW 16 OF 1973)**

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Traffic (Amendment) Law, 1982.

Amendment of section
10 of Law 16 of 1973.

2. Section 10 of the Traffic Law, in this Law referred to as the principal Law, is amended by substituting “Bicycles” for “Bicyles” in the ninth line of subsection (3).

Amendment of section
12.

3. Section 12 of the principal Law is amended by inserting “and no parts for any of such vehicles” immediately after “vehicle” in the fourth line.

Insertion of new
section 12A.

4. The principal Law is amended by inserting the following new section immediately after section 12 -

Amendment of section
13.

5. Section 13 of the principal Law is amended by inserting “and no parts for any such motorcycle” immediately after “centimetres” in the second line.

Amendment of section
14.

6. Section 14 of the principal Law is amended by substituting “motorcycle” for “ motorcylce” in the first line.
