A LAW TO AMEND
THE TRAFFIC LAW (REVISED)

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

Citation.

1. This Law may be cited as the Traffic (Amendment) (No. 2) Law, 1989.

Amendment of s. 34.

2. Section 34(4) of the Traffic Law (Revised) in this Law referred to as the Principal Law, is amended by -

(a) addition of the following words immediately after the word “motorcycles” where it appears in line four thereof -

“with a cylinder capacity not exceeding 125 cubic centimetres,”;

(b) addition of the following new Group immediately after “Group 1” -

“Group 1(a) motorcycles with a cylinder capacity exceeding 125 cubic centimetres”.

Amendment to section 39.

3. Section 39 of the principal Law is amended by addition of the following new subsection immediately after subsection (2) -

“(3) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (1) of this section, no person shall be granted a provisional licence in respect of a motorcycle with a cylinder capacity in excess of 125 cubic centimetres until and unless he has held a full Group
