**A LAW TO AMEND
THE TRAFFIC LAW (REVISED)**

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Traffic (Amendment) Law, 1993.

Section 12A
repealed and
replaced.

2. Section 12A of the Traffic Law (Revised) is repealed and the following section substituted -

"Restriction on
large buses.

(1) A person must not bring a large bus to the Islands without first obtaining the written approval of the Governor for the importation of the vehicle.

Penalty: Fine not exceeding \$5,000

(2) A person must not use a large bus in the Islands except with and in accordance with the written approval of the Governor.

Penalty: Fine not exceeding \$5,000

(3) In this section "large bus" means a bus which –

(a) is more than 10 feet high; or
